Senior Policy Analyst, Public Management and Budgeting Division, OECD

Responsible for Sustainable Finance, French Treasury

She also manages the publication of allocation and performance reports and manages investor relations. Victoire holds a Master in Management from ESSEC Business School and a CFA Institute Certificate in ESG Investing.

Head of the Sustainable Finance Office, Ministry of Finance of Chile

She currently serves as the Head of the Sustainable Finance Office, which she was responsible for institutionalizing during the previous administration.
